Women's 36 Hole Amateur Stroke Play Championship

1. **Monday, December 5th, 7:30 a.m. Double Tee (1st and 10th tee).** Check-in one (1) hour prior to your start time. **Tuesday, December 6th, 8:00 a.m. Shotgun, 6:30 a.m. check-in.**
2. 2011 USGA Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Hawaii Kai Golf Course shall apply.
3. Cellular phones and pagers will not be allowed on the golf course.
4. Carts are mandatory, there will be no walking or caddies allowed.
5. USGA approved Rangefinders or GPS yardage measuring devices will be allowed.
6. Tournament committee reserves the right to adjust flight assignments and handicaps.
7. Starting times will be posted after verifying GHIN Handicaps, 1 December 2011. Call the golf shop for tee times or check the HSWGGA website, www.hawaiiikagolf.com
8. **THERE WILL BE NO SPECTATORS ALLOWED ON THE GOLF COURSE.**

- Entry Fee: \$135 Entry Fee – **\$125 Early entry discount to applications received before November 15th.** Entry Fee includes 2 days of golf including cart, tee gift package, continental breakfast and awards banquet.
- Format: Women's 36 Hole Amateur Stroke Play Championship
- Eligibility: Amateur women 16 years or older with an established GHIN handicap index of 32.6 or less as of Nov. 16, 2011. Please submit your GHIN number on the application for verification.
- Practice: Practice rounds are from November 28 – December 2, 2011 after 12 p.m. only. Cost is \$29. Please call the Pro Shop (395-2358 ext. 2) for a tee time. Driving range will open at 6 a.m. and the range balls are free to all participants prior to their starting times on the tournament days.
- Entry Date: No telephone entries. Entries not accepted will be notified. No refunds after November 25, 2011.
- Flights: Championship, A, B, C, D Flights are to be determined by the number of entries.
- Awards: **\$5000 in merchandise awards & lucky number drawings.** Awards will be given for gross and net scores in the first three (3) places in A, B, C and D flights. The Championship flight will be given awards for the top six (6) gross scores. Tournament Champion will be the lowest 36-hole stroke play score. Awards banquet to follow the completion of the Tournament on Tuesday, December 6th. Limited guest banquet tickets are available for \$35.
